COST TO CLIENT: Male Cat = \$35, Female Cat = \$50;
Male Dog = \$65, Female Dog = \$65
No Additional fee for pregnancy, heat or crypt
Rabies Vaccines = \$10.00; Distemper Vaccine = \$10.00

PERFORMS EARLY SPAY/NEUTER: 3 Months of age for cats; 3 Months of age for dogs
