HOW MANY DAYS PER WEEK? 6

HOURS (START AND FINISH TIME): 10A.M. – 7:00P.M.

GEOGRAPHIC AREA/COUNTIES COVERED: no geographic restrictions

HOW MANY ANIMALS S/N PER DAY? 30-40

NUMBER OF ANIMALS S/N SINCE INCEPTION: 27,000

SPECIES COVERED: Dogs, cats (domestic & feral)

SIZE OF BUILDING: Recently moved from an 800 square-foot building to the 3,000 square-foot building pictured above

SOURCE(S) OF FUNDING FOR STARTUP: Dr. Land had a private practice already. The spay/neuter clinic evolved from the general practice, which has now been reduced to outpatient only.

COST OF EQUIPMENT: 50K approximately

VET FOUND THROUGH: Private practice already in existence

STAFF: 1 veterinarian; 6 full-time staff members, 4 part-time

SOURCE(S) OF FUNDING FOR ONGOING OPERATION: spay/neuter fees; grant money and private donations; subsidized by outpatient clinic.

COST TO CLIENT: Male Cat = \$29, Female Cat = \$39;
Dogs (price varies by weight) = \$49-\$69
Additional fee for pregnancy \$15 for cats; \$20 for dogs
Rabies Vaccines = \$12
Rescue groups, shelters or persons with proof of low-income may be eligible for further rate reductions.

PERFORMS EARLY SPAY/NEUTER: 6 Weeks of age for cats; 6 Weeks of age for dogs
